To the attention of the President of the Commission of Inquiry,

I am opposed to this project and ask the competent authorities to refuse to authorize its implementation.

I have been a frequent visitor to your beautiful region for many years, enjoying the peace of the countryside, the open views, the wildlife, the bats, the birds and in particular the migrating sandhill cranes twice a year. This is not the place for industrial turbines. Your region will lose out in many ways, I ask you how you will attract tourists when 200 of these turbines are clustered in your area. How will you keep people coming to live and invest in your area for their second homes. How will you ever pay back your citizens for all that they will lose? Their livelihoods, their health, their ability to sleep, their property values? How will you rebuild the conflicted communities, divided between those who will benefit from this project and those who will lose everything?

Will you invest in more emergency service equipment to reach the top of the masts in case of engine fires, as has happened with other turbines?

How will you offset the carbon footprint of all the concrete poured into the ground?

You need to answer these questions if you want this project to go ahead.
